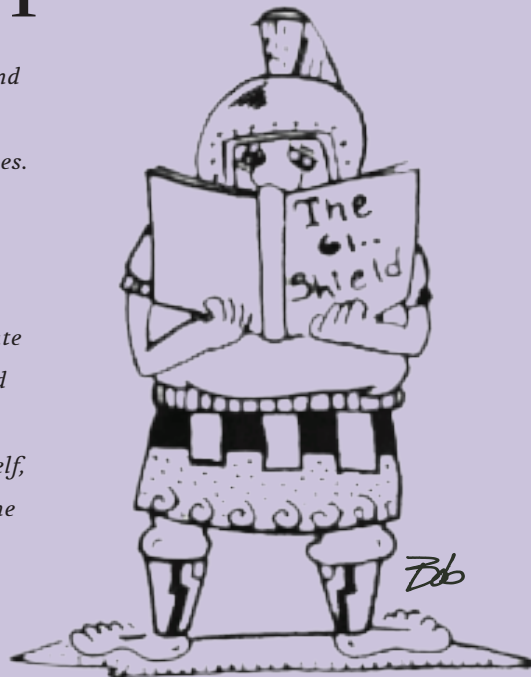
BOB, THE ARTIST

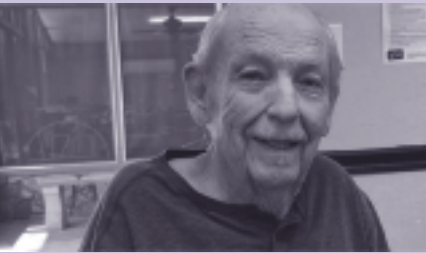
